Financial statements were presented to the council and J. Halvorson motioned to approve them and M. Johnson seconded.

Minutes were presented to council, motioned to approve them J. Halvorson and D. Caswell seconded.

Old business:

To fix the culvert between the Hall and the CoOp office it will cost about \$1,000. This project was approved by D. Caswell and M. Johnson.

The streets will be bladed this Friday if the weather cooperates. If it rains on Thursday this will help with the process of blading the streets. We will also start looking at putting gravel down in some of the areas of the city that it is needed.

New business:

Delinquent water bills were discussed. We will start tagging people that are 2 months late. The Water Bill ordinance to include you have to pay past Due amount before it will be turned on.

Lagoon needs to have work done on it. It will need to be drained some and the walk way will need to be repaired.

The park board will be taken over by the City Council. There will be a separate meeting for park business that will occur after the City Council meeting. This change was proposed by M Johnson and Seconded by D Caswell. It was passed by the council.

The city will be looking at getting new city signs that will be located at the NE corner of Traill 1 and Traill 16. The second sign will be located next to the Kylo seed area. These signs estimate will cost \$1000. The Traill Co Economic Development will match this cost up to \$1000.

We will be having a city Rummage sale Thursday August 18th at the City Hall. If you would like to reserve a spot you will have to get ahold of Julie Johnson.

With all business concluded the meeting was adjourned with a motion by Johnson and second by J. Halvorson. Our next meeting will be held on August 8th. The city council meeting is the 2nd Monday of the even month.
